Detailed directions for concerts in 2024

We are very much looking forward to a special year of concerts at the RheinEnergieSTADION. MUSE, Beyoncé, P!NK and AnnenMayKantereit are all set to thrill the public with their shows!

As well as many locals, we are also expecting visitors from far and wide. We know from experience that large crowds can lead to heavy traffic around the RheinEnergieSTADION.

To avoid being stuck in traffic, **we recommend that you arrive early, come by public transport and/or use the P+R facilities** on the approach roads to Cologne.

(Tip: Your concert ticket is also valid as a public transport ticket on the KVB buses and trams as well as on trains within the VRS transport network, so there are **no additional costs!**)

Arriving by public transport

Getting to the RheinEnergieSTADION is very easy – just take the **KVB tram number 1 or 7**, or the **S-Bahn line S12 or S19**. If you are travelling by train, the best stations to change onto tram number 1 are “Köln Messe/Deutz” and “Köln Weiden West”.

The number 1 tram stops right outside the RheinEnergieSTADION. Before and after concerts, the KVB provides additional trams on line 1 to take visitors to the RheinEnergieSTADION and back into the city centre or to the “Köln Weiden West” station.

Coming from the south, tram number 7 serves the RheinEnergieSTADION, which is within walking distance of the “Stüttgenhof” stop. For all five concerts, Kölner Sportstätten GmbH will provide a free shuttle service from the “Haus Vorst/Marsdorf” stop, which will take concert goers to the “Südallee/Junkersdorf” bus stop near the stadium. The service will be available from 4:00 pm on the day of each concert. After the concerts, the shuttle service will run for 90 minutes to bring visitors back to the “Haus Vorst/Marsdorf” stop.

Arriving by bike

There are approx 3,000 **bicycle stands** around the RheinEnergieSTADION.

They can be found in the following locations:

- Junkersdorfer Straße
- On the corner of Heinrich-Billstein-Weg/Olympiaweg

Arriving by car and using P+R facilities and car parks

We recommend:

- P&R Marsdorf (Haus Vorst)
- P&R Weiden West
- Car park Köln Arcaden shopping centre

For all five concerts, Kölner Sportstätten GmbH will provide a free shuttle service from the Marsdorf P+R facility ("Haus Vorst"), which will take concert goers to the "Südallee/Junkersdorf" bus stop near the stadium. The service will be available from 4:00 pm on the day of each concert. After the concerts, the shuttle service will run for 90 minutes to bring visitors back again.

Arriving by car/coach and using the stadium car parks

If you are coming by **car** or **coach**, you can get to the RheinEnergieSTADION via the orbital motorway "Kreuz Köln West" (A1/A4). On the A1, take the "Köln Bocklemünd", "Köln Lövenich" or "Köln Weiden/Frechen" exits. On the A4, take the "Köln Klettenberg" or "Frechen Nord" exits. Once you have left the motorway, follow the signs to the stadium.

There are approx **7,500 car parking spaces** around the RheinEnergieSTADION plus the P8 coach park.
